PROJECT OVERVIEW

Both NHS Bedfordshire and Dr Cakebread and Partners, a GP Practice, required a new and custom built facility to enable the continued delivery of key medical care within the area of Shefford. Due to the lack of available land within the area, this £3.7 million star shaped mix of both single and two storey wings was developed on greenbelt land.

The development of this specialist medical facility did not stay stay static as part way through actual development, it was decided that Bedford Hospital and the Primary Care Trust would retain ownership of the lease upon completion. This decision had a significant impact upon the development as a partial internal layout redesign was now required to meet the needs of the PCT. In addition the new centre would now need to comply with hospital standards and regulations, and as such a number of alterations were made.
